As a result, the WWNA has contacted the Greenlight Networks team and invited them to our May meeting to share more with us. Greenlight Networks is in the build out stages of developing fiber optic infrastructure and decides in which neighborhoods to build in based on resident interest. The speeds of Greenlight average out to be much faster than those of Time Warner but for about the same or less cost.
