

Winona Woods General Meeting Notes Aug 4, 2014

Discussion: Greenlight Update (Jeremy Morgante)

- * Initial assumptions by Greenlight did not include full engineering survey due to cost
- * Some streets are delayed due to permit processes
- * Some streets are delayed temporarily due to higher than expected constructions costs
- * 16 Additional sign ups are needed on Chapel Hill, Carriage Lane and parts of Chestnut Hill, & Belcoda
- * Sachem Way on hold indefinitely due to underground wiring
- * Some service is hooked up and users are very pleased with speed and reliability
- * Greenlight using us as an example to learn better practices in communications and logistics

Discussion: HIPP & Irondequoit Plaza Status (Jeff Goldblatt)

- * HIPP = Helping Irondequoit Plan for Progress
- * HIPP participates in a variety of initiatives and has been involved in negotiations to make improvements at Irondequoit Plaza (Hudson/Titus)
- * Nick Waetherby, newly appointed director of developmental services for the town, is working with HIPP and plaza developers to create a cleaner, more well-maintained environment at the site
- * Additional Support from the community could help elevate priority
 - * Letters to Supervisor
 - * Speakers at public input
- * Some commitments have been made but no progress has been reported:
 - * Replace Canopies
 - * Replace Fixtures
 - * Lighting improvements
 - * Litter management improvement
 - * Some benches have been removed but not replaced

Activity: Speed Meets (Amy DeYaeger)

- * Activity designed to get everyone talking to each other and make some new connections with people from their neighborhood.
- * Participants were divided into two equal groups
- * Tables were set up so everyone was sitting directly across from someone they don't know
Group A sat on one side, Group B sat on the other
- * Each pair of people sitting directly across from each other was given an index card, face down
- * After a moment to introduce themselves, each team was asked to turn over their card and have a 2 minute discussion on the topic printed on the front.
- * After two minutes, Group A remained seated and Group B was asked to get up and move to a chair across from another person they didn't know.
- * The game was repeated with Group B staying seated and Group A moving at the end of discussion time
- * New cards were handed out each round.
