Neighborhood Watch

Sticking together and keeping our eyes peeled is one way we keep our streets safe and property secure. If it doesn't seem right, call 911.

Neighbors in Need:

Winona Woods offers a friendly check in program for neighbors who may have a disability, have long or short term health concerns or might need infrequent light assistance.

New Resident's Guide

You probably have a lot of questions about trash haulers, yard waste pick up and parking. All the answers to those questions and more can be found in the Town of Irondequoit New Resident's Guide which can be found both on their website and ours.

Here are some important town ordinances:

Trash Pickup:

Trash is picked up by licensed trash haulers a complete list can be found at <http://bit.ly/wastehaulers>. Trash cans must have lids and should not be placed at the curb until 4:00 the day prior to pickup. Once emptied, trash cans need to be stored behind the front foundation line of your home.

Dogs:

Residents may have up to two dogs, they must be leashed when off the owner's property. All dogs older than 4 months need to be licensed.

Permits:

In Irondequoit you need a permit for items like sheds, fences, stoops, additions, pools and hot tubs. Be sure to get in touch with the town building department to stay in compliance.

Parking:

Parking is disallowed on sidewalks, rights of way, front and side yards. Please keep your car on the driveway. From November 1 until April 15 there is no parking on town streets from midnight until 9 AM.
